



ePosters at ICCBH

Message for poster presenters

This year for the first time ICCBH will be offering you the opportunity to display and present your poster on an ePoster screen in addition to your regular poster.

We're excited to be able to offer this opportunity and hope that you will decide to take part. We realise that the concept is still relatively new, so just a few more words of explanation.

What we would like you to do:

1. Bring your poster as already confirmed in your abstract acceptance notification. This is for presentation on the traditional boards and should stay in place for the entire meeting. Odd numbers to be presented 12:00-13:00 on Sunday 11 June, Even numbers 12:00-13:00 on Monday 12 June. Poster presenter instructions [here](#).
2. Submit a PDF of your poster (or PowerPoint if you're including a video or animation) to be displayed on the ePoster screens. All posters submitted will be accessible on all of the screens. Readers will be able to:
 - View all posters on a single screen
 - Scroll through one by one or search to find specific posters of interest (eg by topic or author name)
 - Zoom in on your data
 - Click on hyperlinks
 - View videos
 - Save your poster or email it to themselves (if you give permission)
 - Email you to arrange to meet or to ask a question

Please follow the instructions in Justus' email to register for the system and to upload your poster. The deadline is 1 June.

If you haven't received the instructions on how to upload your poster please let us know and we'll arrange for it to be sent to you again.

3. Let us know if you would like to take part in a moderated ePoster session. During the Sunday and Monday morning and afternoon coffee breaks there will be moderated ePoster sessions when you can present your data to groups of delegates

using the touch screen to zoom in and navigate. A microphone and laser pointer will be available. ePoster presentations will each be 3 minutes plus 2 for questions.

We need to know in advance if you wish your poster to be considered for inclusion in a moderated ePoster session. The deadline for letting us know is **12 May**. You can indicate your interest by filling in [this form](#).

As said, this is an additional opportunity, and does not replace the traditional poster board presentations or any other presentations you may already be giving such as poster pitches, etc.

We hope that you will find this new technology useful, both as a presenter and as an audience member, and we will welcome your feedback.
